

# Wildlife & Water Safari - Queen Elizabeth National Park - 2024 - 3 days /2Nights





The 3 Day/2 Nights adventure takes you to a medley of wonders - Queen Elizabeth National Park. The park has got rich diverse ecosystems covering the sprawling savanna, shady, humid forests, sparkling lakes and wetlands. This makes the park a habitat for classic big game, over 10 primate species including chimpanzees and over 600 species of birds. The jagged Rwenzori Mountains, popularly known as Mountains of the moon, gives this park a perfect backdrop!



### Itinerary at a glance.

Day 1: Drive from Kampala/Entebbe – Queen Elizabeth.

Day 2: Game drive in Queen Elizabeth National Park & Boat cruise on the Kazinga channel.

Day 3: Drive back to Kampala/Entebbe.

### Detailed itinerary.

### Day 1: Kampala/Entebbe - Queen Elizabeth National Park - App. 8 hours' drive.

Adventure Consults' representative will pick from your residence/hotel by 0730 hrs. (latest), briefing on your safari and start the adventure. Beginning with a panoramic drive west of Uganda.

On payment of supplement, USD 338 per person, today, you have an option to take a one-hour flight advance reservation is a must!

You will stop at the Equator Crossing line for interesting practical experiments/demonstrations. There are only 13 countries in the world that are crossed by the equator, and Uganda is one of them. You will watch and listen to the site guide as he demonstrates interesting facts using water. If you love random curious facts, this is the right place. The experiments will take you back to old school physics and Geography classes. Don't miss out the photo-op at the equator line with the monument as your photo frame.

The drive from Entebbe to the Equator crossing is about 2 - 3 hours and the site visit takes 30 - 45 minutes.

Continue onwards to Mbarara town for lunch then after proceed to the park arriving late afternoon/evening.

Meals and Overnight at Mweya Safari Lodge.

Inclusions: All Meals (Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner).

Exclusions: All drinks.



#### Day 2: Game drive & Boat cruise on the Kazinga channel.

Make sure you are by 0600 hours so that you don't miss out the colorful sunrise session!

After a cup of coffee/tea, go for a game drive. As the sun peeps out of the broken clouds, it reflects on the savannahs, creating shady moments. The sparkling sunlight reflection on the lakes and green wetlands gives the best moment for big game and birds to hang out.

The game tracks here never disappoint! There are high chances of sighting the Leopard, African bush elephants, Hippos, Lions, Cape buffaloes, and several antelope species.

Enjoy a Picnic Breakfast at a beautiful site by the community craft market, facing Lake Bunyampaka. Depending on the season, you might see the colorful flamingos in a distance.

After lunch, drive to the Mweya pier in time for the 2 pm boat cruise on the Kazinga Channel. The channel is a 32-kilometer- long natural water stretch that links Lake Edward and George.

The boat cruise on the channel provides the best opportunities for up-close animal viewing and photography with lots of hippos and numerous Nile crocodiles. Queen Elizabeth National Park's bird life is rich, colorful, and stupendous totaling to 600 recorded species.

We normally book scheduled boats. The type of boat to use (either big or small) is to be determined on the day of the boat trip. Private/exclusive boats are available on payment of supplement.

Weather permitting, go for a sundowner and have a taste of Uganda's finest gin, and a mix of both local and premium drinks as you look at the sun dipping in the horizon. Note that snacks and soft drinks on house, all alcoholic drinks are on own account.

### Day 3: Queen Elizabeth - Entebbe or Kampala - app. 8 hours' drive.

After breakfast, drive out of the park, keeping an eye out for game. With stops at places of interest, proceed to Kampala, drop off at your residence or proceed to the airport in time for your return flight or drop off

Please book return flights departing after 6 pm to avoid a rushed day.

PS — Today, you have an option to take a one-hour flight and will be payment of supplement — **USD 338 per person** including hotel-airport transfer. You need to book this in advance.
