



***Wildlife &
the River Nile
Adventure
Murchison
Falls National park.***

Overview: A 3 day/2 nights trip to **Murchison Falls**, starting and ending in Kampala or Entebbe. The road drive is scenic and involves interesting stop-overs with a visit to the top of Murchison falls, game drives and a boat cruise to the bottom of the powerful falls.

Itinerary at a glance

Day 1: Entebbe or Kampala to Murchison Falls National Park by road.

Day 2: Morning Game Drive & Afternoon Boat ride on the river Nile.

Day 3: Visit to the top of Murchison falls. Drive back to Entebbe or Kampala.

Detailed Itinerary

Day 1: Entebbe to Murchison Falls National Park; Approx. 6-7 hours' drive.

Meet at the hotel or residence and start the journey to Murchison falls. Highly recommend early morning departure – 08:00 hours latest or earlier.

The journey to the sprawling Murchison falls National Park is filled with mind-blowing countryside views, busy towns and roadside markets. Depending on departure time and traveler's choice, you may have lunch enroute or proceed to the lodge inside the park arriving in time for lunch.

Murchison Falls National Park is the largest Protected Area in Uganda measuring 3,840 square kilometers. The park sits in the Northwestern part of Uganda and shelters over 76 mammal species that include the big game, over 500 bird species and over 250 butterfly species.

This afternoon, you have an option to either drive to the top of Murchison Falls or have an evening game drive. The top of the powerful falls is a vantage top point that offers the best opportunity for viewing the perfected Nile's beauty as it's forced through a seven-meter cleft in the rocks. The waters plunge 45 meters down, forming a spectacular rainbow. This area forms the best backdrop for photography and appreciating creation!

Meals and Overnight at Paraa Lodge or similar.

Inclusions: All Meals (Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner).

Exclusions: All drinks.

Day 2: Game Drive & Afternoon Boat ride on the river Nile.

Have a cup of your favorite beverage (coffee or tea) and head out for an early morning game drive (starting at 6:00 am, and lasting 3-4 hours). Keep an eye out in the thickets, trees, and ground for rewarding Wildlife viewing and photography opportunities. After the game drive, you will return to the lodge for a full breakfast.

Lunch at the lodge. You will later head out to the jetty for a 2pm boat ride to the bottom of Murchison falls. You will cruise upstream by boat on the calm Victoria Nile, providing an opportunity for getting close to Nile crocodiles as well as Hippos, and lots of Birds. Regular visitors to the riverbanks include elephants, giraffes, buffaloes, Uganda Kobs, and a plethora of aquatic birds. The Boat ride on the Nile will take you to the base of the falls just tens of meters from the "Devil's Cauldron".

We usually consider scheduled boats. The type of boat to use (either big or small) is to be determined on the day of the boat trip. Private/exclusive boats are available on payment of supplement.

Meals and Overnight at Paraa Lodge or similar.

Inclusions: All Meals (Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner).

Exclusions: All drinks.

Day 3: Morning Game drive – Return to Kampala/Entebbe.

You may have a relaxed morning or have a morning game drive and look out for more big game. Alternatively, you may visit the top of the falls (if not done on day 1).

Check-out and exit the park. You may have lunch enroute, and proceed to Kampala or Entebbe.

If you have a connecting international/regional flight today, ensure it's scheduled to depart Entebbe no earlier than 16:00 hours.

Per person cost (depending on number of participants).

Safari price inclusions: Accommodation with meals as indicated in the itinerary, Ground transport in a custom-built safari Land cruiser/s with fuel and English-speaking driver/guides, all activities as mentioned in the itinerary (unless specified as extras), and Government taxes.

Safari price EXCLUDES: International flights, Visas where applicable, airport departure taxes, insurance, costs related to itinerary changes after confirmation any services, activities not included in itinerary, any costs incurred due to canceled or delayed flights, acts of nature, insecurity or other circumstances beyond our control, any related costs of personal nature like gratuities, drinks (other than those included at particular properties) telephone calls, internet services and laundry.



Payment schedule: You are required to make a deposit payment of 20% of the safari price plus cost of Gorilla & Chimp permits (where applicable) to consider the safari confirmed. Final payment to be paid 60 days prior to safari start date. Note that this schedule is based on service providers' booking terms and conditions.

Payment mode: We accept payments by Telegraphic Transfers, cheques or Cash. Please get in touch with accounts@adventureconsults.com for more details or if you have any queries.
